


Social Impact of each modality per passenger KM



Experience with aggregators

Full Integration

- No need to download Donkey App
- Book, pay, unlock through aggregator

Live with 4 aggregators.

Another ~5 expected in 2022.

Partial Integration

- See price, availability
- Refer to Donkey app with deeplink to selected bike

Live with 15 aggregators.

GoogleMaps is the only one doing anything.

Rejseplanen performance: 1% of GoogleMaps.

Future thoughts

Full integration is >10x more effective in converting compared to partial integration - when riders do not already have the operator's app.

All large tech companies want to become THE AGGREGATOR (and they execute much more effectively compared to public authorities)

Main risks:

- Platform companies also operating some modes => push people to their own vehicles and mainly to cars.
- Public authorities not letting effective parters handle aggregation

Solution:

- Regulate such that operators cannot become platforms
- Open up selling of public ticketing
